Brut Réserve, Champagne, FRA, NV

A wonderfully balanced Champagne from this classic house with refreshing citrus and brioche character

Bollinger 98

Brut, 'Special Cuvée', Champagne, FRA, NV

A full-bodied Champagne of great class with bread and baked apple notes and a refined, delicate mousse

Billecart-Salmon 110

Grand Cru Blanc de Blancs, Brut, Champagne, FRA, NV

Made entirely from Grand Cru Chardonnay. This cuvée will surprise with its pure intensity of the dry fruit aromas, almonds & creamy sensation

| Trebbiano d’Abruzzo ‘Frentano’, Cantina Frentana, Abruzzo, ITA, 2019 A light and easy wine from Eastern Italy with crisp orchard fruit character and a clean mineral finish | 26 |
| Picpoul de Pinet Grange des Roccs, Languedoc, FRA, 2020 A classic of the Mediterranean, dry and refreshing with a tangy saline and citrus finish | 28 |
| Albariño Diluvio, Rias Baixas, ESP, 2020 A persistent and complex wine, lots of freshness with fruits and white flowers | 35 |
| Sauvignon Blanc Touraine, ‘Flint’, C. & D. Delecheneau, Loire Valley, FRA, 2019 A light, crisp and refreshing white wine with lots of classic Sauvignon citrus and elderflower character | 35 |
| Riesling ‘Trocken, ‘Gönnheimer’, Weingut Eymann, Pfalz, GER 2019 Slightly of f-dry, incredibly intense, taut and mineral. Bright aromas of citrus and pineapple fruit and classic Riesling acidity | 40 |
| Cortese Gavi di Gavi, Tacchino, Piedmont, ITA, 2019 A classic expression of Gavi – crisp, mineral with underlying lemon zest. A wine that never disappoints! | 39 |
| Chardonnay Chablis, Domaine Roland Lavantureux, Burgundy, FRA, 2019 A classic Chablis with a delicious balance of crisp citrus fruit and wet stone with a vibrant acidity | 49 |

RED WINE

- Grenache – Cabernet Sauvignon 25
Alchemist, Valerie Courreges, Provence, FRA, 2017
An easy drinking soft, medium bodied wine bursting with red fruit, spiciness and fresh acidity
- Montepulciano d’Abruzzo 27
‘Frentano’, Cantina Frentana, Abruzzo, ITA, 2019
A rich, dark-fruit dominated red that has good tannic structure but enough acidity to be drunk on its own
- Cabernet Sauvignon 33
Bodega Cecchin, Mendoza, ARG, 2018
A young and fruity Cabernet with ripe dark fruit and a hint of peppery spice
- Gamay 39
Côte-de-Brouilly, Nicole Chanrion, Beaujolais, FRA 2019
A silky smooth Côtes du Rhône with great acidity and crunchy red fruit character mingling with a touch of spice
- Corvina – Rondinella 41
Valpolicella Classico, ‘Saseti’, Monte dall’Ora, Veneto, ITA, 2020
Vibrant, juicy, snappy red fruits make this an easy-drinking red but its rustic core allows it to pair with food beautifully
- Malbec 44
Cahors, ‘Le Combal’, Domaine Cosse Maisonneuve, South West, FRA, 2014
Cahors is the hometown of Malbec, this is an elegant yet rustic wine with minerality and depth from the region’s rising star
- Grenache - Syrah 45
‘Le Vallon’, Domaine Henri Milan, Provence, FRA, 2018
A complex blend of 5 grapes, with spice, dark fruit and earth, this wine makes a mockery of its ‘table wine’ status
- Merlot 49
‘Duc des Nauves’, Château Le Puy, Bordeaux, FRA, 2019
A wonderful example of Right Bank Bordeaux: supple, rounded dark fruits combine with herbaceous and earthy notes
- Pinot Noir 69
Marsannay, Domaine Charlopin-Tissier, Burgundy, FRA, 2015
A classy and elegant Pinot Noir with a combination of ripe red fruit, smoke and earthy notes
- Merlot 74
‘Emilien’, Chateau Le Puy, Bordeaux, FRA, 2014
Elegance is an understatement. Supple, rounded with complex fruit and mineral notes lifted by an impressive acidity. Bordeaux at its most approachable

PUDDING WINE

Jurançon 65

'Mon Plaisir', Domaine de Souch, South West, FRA, 2017

A fantastic alternative to Sauternes, offering ripe apricot flavours with exotic ginger and honey that is lifted by an orange zest acidity

FORTIFIED WINE

Pedro Ximenez 40

Gutierrez Colosia, Jerez, ESP, NV (37.5cl)

Lusciously sweet, this wine, made from raisined grapes, is abundant in prune, fig and date flavours – great with chocolate, vanilla ice cream and by itself!

Vintage Port 110

Quinta de la Rosa, Douro Valley, PRT 2004

A full-bodied and full-flavoured Port with a wonderful balance of ripe black fruit and sweet spice
